FPQ2107, finished 48.5" x 56.5"

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Yardage is based on 42.5" of usable fabric.

Fabric A	1 yard
Fabric B	1 yard
Fabric C	1 yard
Backing	3 1/4 yards

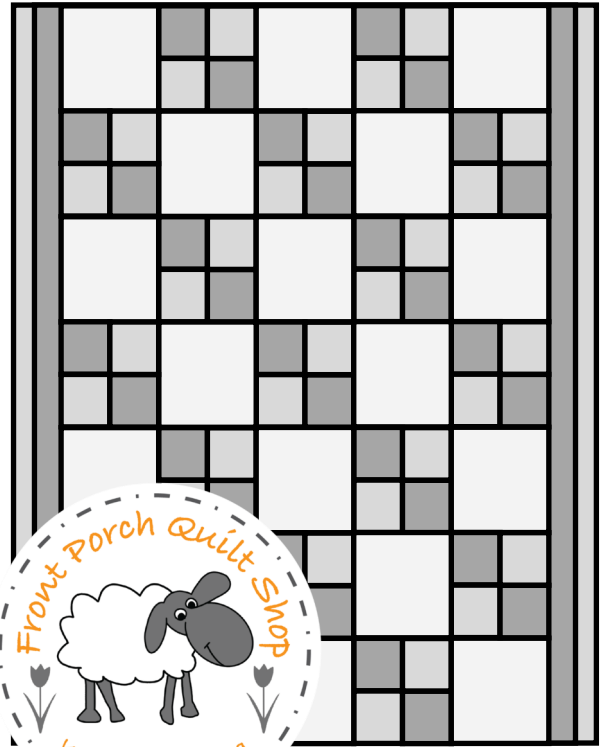

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CUTTING

Fabric A

(4) 8.5" x wof (width of fabric)
(18) 8.5" x 8.5" focal squares. *Take extra care to cut 5 blocks from each strip.*

Fabric B

(4) 4.5" x wof (width of fabric)
(6) 2.5" X wof border and scrappy binding

Fabric C

(4) 4.5" x wof (width of fabric)
(6) 2.5" X wof border and scrappy binding

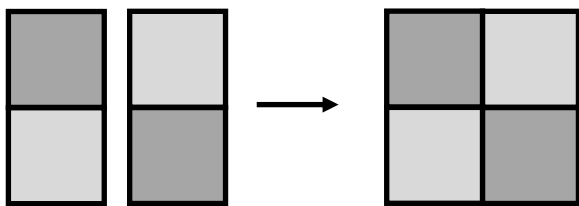
ASSEMBLY

Strip Piecing

Sew a 4.5" B strip together with a 4.5" C strip pressing towards the darker fabric. Make 4 strip sets. Sub-cut strip sets into (34) 4.5" units.



Sew 2 units previously made, together into a 4-patch block pressing open. Make 17 blocks.



Using diagram as a guide, sew 5 blocks together, alternating 8.5" focal squares with 4-patch blocks pressing towards Fabric A. Make 7 rows. Sew rows together and press open.

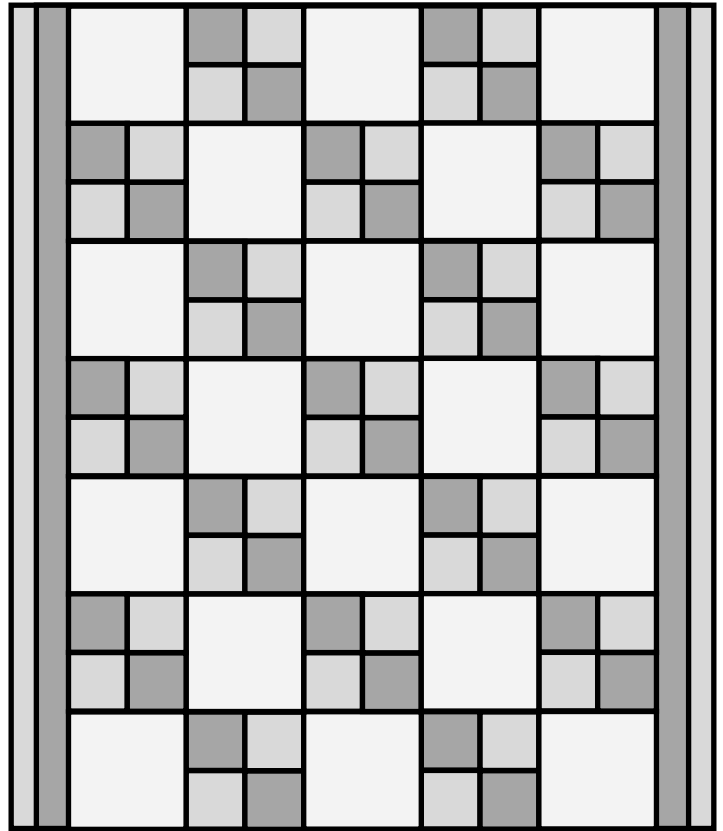
BORDERS

Sew (3) 2.5" x wof B strips together end to end on the diagonal, removing excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam allowance and press open. Sub-cut into (2) 2.5" x 56.5" for inner border.

Repeat previous border steps using (3) 2.5" x wof C strips and sub-cut into (2) 2.5" x 56.5" for outer border.

Sew inner border to both sides of quilt top pressing outwards.

Sew outer border to both sides of quilt top pressing outwards.



For a scrappier binding, you may choose to cut a few strips 21" long. Sew binding strips together end to end on the diagonal, remove excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

Layer with batting and backing, quilt as desired and bind.
