LEARN TO SINGLE CROCHET

Participants will learn to hold a crochet hook, maintain tension, and perform chain and single crochet stitches. This class is ideal for beginners, accommodating both right and left-handed individuals. Supplies, including yarn and a crochet hook, are provided.

Beginning Crochet for Adults, ages 16 & up

Beginning Crochet for Children, ages 10-15

Length of Class: 1.5 hours Maximum Attendance: 12

Class Fee: \$75, \$5/person supply fee



AMIGURIMI STYLE CROCHET

Learn Amigurumi crochet to create cute animals, fruits, and veggies. We'll start with a magic circle and adjust stitches while crocheting in a circle to create a small ball. **Knowledge of single crochet is required.** Bring your own crochet hook (F-H size) and medium weight acrylic yarn.

Length of Class: 2 hours Maximum Attendance: 12

Class Fee: \$100, \$5/person supply fee



CROCHET A BORDER ON A FLEECE BLANKET

In this class, you'll learn to add a crocheted border to a fleece baby blanket, enhancing its appearance while practicing single crochet skills. Bring your own F-H size crochet hook. Fleece and yarn will be provided.

Length of Class: 2 hours Maximum Attendance: 10

Class Fee: \$100, \$5/person supply fee



LEARN TO KNIT

Participants will learn how to hold a pair of knitting needles, cast on, and beginner knit stitches. Participants receive knitting needles and two balls of yarn to use and take home.

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LEARN TO USE YOUR SEWING MACHINE

Learn to use the basic functions of your own sewing machine. You will learn to thread the machine, wind a bobbin, make adjustments, and use the features of your machine. Bring the following supplies: sewing machine, scissors, thread, pins, fabric, presser feet, bobbins, seam ripper.

Length of Class: 2 hours Maximum Attendance: 6

Class Fee: \$100, \$5/person supply fee



QUILT BLOCKS 101

In this class you will learn to make three beginner quilt blocks. Bring your own sewing machine and sewing supplies including scissors, thread, pins, seam ripper, fabric, presser feet, bobbins. You should be able to thread your machine and bobbin and sew a straight seam. Fabric will be provided.

Length of Class: 2 hours Maximum Attendance: 10

Class Fee: \$100, \$5/person supply fee



ENGLISH PAPER PIECING

Learn the relaxing art of English Paper Piecing as you create a charming hexagon flower made of seven hand-sewn hexagons. Using simple hand stitching or glue basting, you'll assemble the traditional *Grandmother's Flower Garden*, a timeless favorite for quilters and beginners alike. It's a fun and calming way to enjoy some creative time and learn a classic sewing skill.

Length of Class: 2 hours Maximum Attendance: 10

Class Fee: \$100, \$10/person supply fee



THREE-FABRIC PILLOWCASE

Learn to make a three-fabric pillowcase using the burrito or hotdog method. Bring your own sewing machine and supplies including scissors, thread, pins, seam ripper, fabric, presser feet, bobbins. Fabric for the pillowcase will be provided.

Length of Class: 2 hours Maximum Attendance: 10

Class Fee: \$100, \$5/person supply fee



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HEAT-N-BOND BASICS

Fuse fabric the fun and easy way! Discover the magic of Heat-n-Bond, a simple fusible webbing that lets you join fabrics together with just an iron. In this hands-on class, you'll learn how to use Heat-n-Bond to decorate clothing, pillow covers, tote bags, bookmarks, and ornaments. We'll show plenty of inspiring samples, and you'll get to make your own fabric bookmark or ornamental coaster to take home. No experience needed. Bring your creativity and we'll supply the rest.

Length of Class: 2 hours Maximum Attendance: 6
Class Fee: \$100, \$5/person supply fee



PAJAMA PANTS PARTY

You will learn to make pajama pants and how to customize a pattern. Bring your own sewing machine and supplies including scissors, thread, pins, seam ripper, presser feet, bobbins. Supplies to make the pajama pants will be provided.

Length of Class: 3 hours Maximum Attendance: 10
Class Fee: \$150, \$10/person supply fee



ZIPPERS AND BUTTONS

Learn how to sew zippers and buttons on your sewing machine. You will learn these skills while making a small pouch with a zipper and a button. Bring your sewing machine, zipper and button foot, thread, scissors, seam ripper. We will provide the supplies to make the pouch.

Length of Class: 2 hours Maximum Attendance: 10
Class Fee: \$100, \$5/person supply fee



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LET'S MAKE FELT BIRDS

Whimsical, colorful, and fun. Create your own cheerful felt bird in this hands-on crafting class. Choose from a buffet of pre-cut felt shapes for bodies, wings, and tails, then use simple running stitches and buttons to bring your bird to life. Mix and match colors, layer your design, and let your creativity soar. No sewing experience needed.

Length of Class: 2 hours Maximum Attendance: 10

Class Fee: \$100, \$5/person supply fee

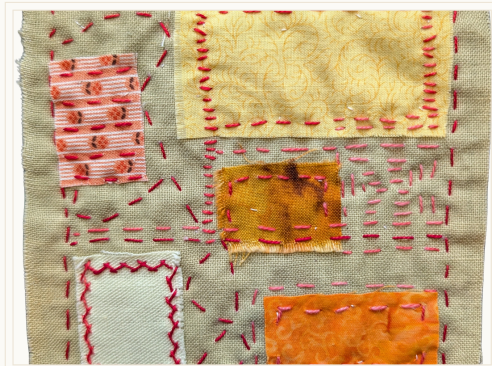


MINDFUL STITCHING WITH UPCYCLED TEXTILES

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HAND-STITCHED FABRIC COASTERS

Create a round or square fabric coaster using simple hand stitching—perfect to keep or gift! All materials provided. Basic hand sewing skills required.

SASHIKO JAPANESE HAND STITCHING

Sashiko is a traditional Japanese hand-sewing technique that uses a running stitch to mend, reinforce, and embellish fabric using geometric and repeating patterns.

PROSPERITY HENS

Join us for a fun and creative craft session! Using recycled materials and simple shapes, you'll design and assemble whimsical "Prosperity Hens" - cheerful symbols meant to bring good fortune and happiness to your home. This is a great scrap project. All supplies included.

MAKE A SENSORY MAT

Sensory Mats are small lap quilts with textured items sewn into the fabric. All ages can hold and fidget with these mats when something is needed to provide a soothing sensory experience that helps reduce stress or anxiety. We will provide all the supplies to make these quilted mats. Bring your own sewing machine and sewing supplies.

Length of Class: 2 hours Maximum Attendance: 10

Class Fee: \$100, \$5/person supply fee

Sew4Service offers a variety of classes taught in our Sewing Studios as well as in libraries, community centers, and schools. Our talented teachers bring years of experience working with people of all ages and abilities. This wealth of experience ensures a high-quality, hands-on learning environment for your patrons. We have teachers available in Cuyahoga, Lake, Geauga, Summit, Portage, Medina and Stark Counties.

We usually bring all the supplies needed for the classes, and charge a small fee per person to cover materials. Each class is designed to be taught by one teacher and is limited to the maximum number of attendees in order to give personal attention to each participant. We recommend adding additional classes of the same type, if needed, at an additional cost.
