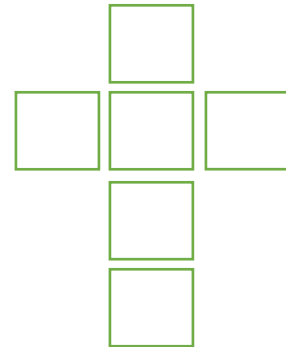


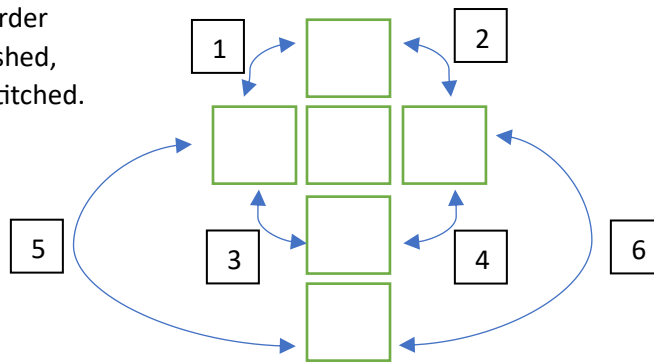
Plushy Cubes Instructions

Plushy Cubes are soft, toss-able cubes. They are made from textured fabrics and stuffed with fabric scraps. They can be used by seniors to toss around as a fun way to work on eye-hand coordination and play games.

1. To make a Plushy Cube, cut out 6 – 5” squares from a variety of textured or soft fabrics.
 - a. Examples of fabric types include cotton, flannel, fleece, corduroy, ribbed or textured cotton blends.
2. Sew the 6 squares to make this pattern.
 - a. For each seam, stop $\frac{1}{4}$ ” from each edge to allow space to sew the other side seams.



3. Sew the other seams in the order indicated. When you are finished, there should be one side unstitched.



4. Stuff the plushy cube with fabric scraps or polyfil until full.
5. Hand stitch the final seam.
